

Oberharz Locations

WELCOME TO THE OBERHARZ!

No matter where you are coming from, you will quickly reach the Oberharz as it is located right in the middle of Germany. Let's briefly introduce ourselves, so you know what you can look forward to on your visit!

Our sites are located at an altitude of 380 to 928 m:

ALTENAU – The spa resort with a healing climate and city of herbs and spices impresses with possibly the largest herb park in Germany. It is an excellent starting point for hikes.

BUNTENBOCK — This district of Clausthal-Zeller-feld enchants with its wonderful mountain meadows and invites you on extensive cross-country tours in winter. Experience the beautiful nature around the numerous ponds in this UNESCO World Heritage Site.

CLAUSTHAL-ZELLERFELD — As university town Clausthal-Zellerfeld is the center of the Oberharz Mountains. It also sports the largest wooden church in Europe, the market church "Zum Heiligen Geist" and plenty of evidence of the mining history of the Harz mountains.

SANKT ANDREASBERG – The national park community near the Brocken is the highest mountain town in the Oberharz. The spa and winter sport resort fulfills the most varied of holiday dreams in every season of the year with its dreamy nature, a pleasant climate and many sporting offers.

SCHULENBERG — This holiday destination offers a beautiful panoramic view over the water reservoir "Okerstausee" - which is a prime site for active holidays in summer and winter.

WILDEMANN – The village is situated picture-squely in the valley of the river "Innerste". The "19-Lachter-Stollen" museum mine is an authentic witness to the history of mining.

TORFHAUS – This Altenau district is located directly in the Harz National Park and its moorlands, with a direct view of the Brocken. After a visit to the National Park Visitor Center or the "Globetrotter Active Store" you can reach the famous "Goetheweg" trail, only 8 km away, leading to the Brocken summit.



E-Biking

Motorized bicycles are becoming more and more popular. With an e-bike, cycling will be a completely new experience: discover the Harz landscape and the sights without much physical effort.

Maps for bike trails and information on e-bike rental stations (from around € 25 per day) are available from our Oberharz Tourist Information Office or on our website

Mountainbiking

For active mountain bikers the Volksbank Harz Arena is one of the highlights: 74 signposted routes with a length of around 2,300 km offer everything that lets the MTBer's heart beat faster: from panoramic tours with fantastic views to tricky trails for the skilled cyclist.

Downhill and freeride fans can get their adrenaline rush and unlimited cycling fun in the Schulenberg Race Park and the mountain roads are ideal for racing bikes.

Hiking and Nordic Walking

The extensive hiking trail network with good signage offers optimal conditions for exploring the diverse landscape. Many hiking routes are also available online with GPS information for download.

One of the most popular hiking trails of the region is the "Harzer-Hexen-Stieg" (witch trail). It leads past the towns of Altenau, Buntenbock, Clausthal-Zellerfeld and Sankt Andreasberg, where you will find good entry points to the trail.

The Harzer "Försterstieg" (ranger's trail) is a 60 km long long-distance hiking trail and leads through the western Harz.

Altenau is a good starting point for the popular endurance sport of Nordic walking.

The DSV nordic active walking center has three certified routes with different gradients and lengths over 4.7 km, 8.7 km and 18.7 km. The different paths through beautiful natural scenery connect a route network of 57.4 km between Altenau and Clausthal-Zellerfeld.





Kayaking, canoeing and archery

The spectrum ranges from paddling fun with canoes on dams and rivers to wild water rafting in the Okertal. The well-known Okertalsperre is the largest water reservoir in the Harz mountains. Here you can take a round trip with the Okersee ship "MS AquaMarin". You can find the most demanding whitewater stretch in Northern Germany -level III-VI on the six-level scale- in the wild and romantic Okertal (valley). It is located between the hydroelectric power station and the Okertalsperre compensation

reservoir and runs over a length of 2 km. Please note the official times of use here.

Archery

The 3D archery parcours near Clausthal-Zellerfeld invites you on 3.5 km to explore the beautiful nature of the Harz region and the traces of historic mining, with water trenches and tunnels. 50 lovingly designed destinations at 22 stations are waiting for you with suitable offers for all ages!

Climbing

In the Harz you have options: you can climb on sandstone rocks, on granite, on porphyrite (Illfeld), on limestone or on greywacke rocks.

Granite rock, hornfels, and siliceous rock can also be found, for example in the Okertal. Flex your muscles on 160 m long ridges and up to 50 m high rock faces and experience the Oberharz mountains from a slightly different perspective.

The best-known climbing rocks that can be climbed individually are the "Adlerklippen" and the "Marienwand". Both are easily accessible via the B498. In Sankt Andreasberg you find one of the highest high ropes courses at 720 metres. Test your courage, skill and balanceon two floors!





Bathing

Lakes in the Oberharz are usually called **bathing ponds**, and there are many of those around. What could be nicer on a hot summer day than jumping into a bathing pond, swimming a few lengths, and refreshing yourself?

In many places in the Oberharz you can find picturesque bathing lakes, ponds, and outdoor pools, many

equipped with showers, toilets and even a kiosk or a restaurant, such as the forest swimming pool "Okerteich" near Altenau.

Fishing

Around 40 ponds and other waters where fishing is possible: the Oberharz region offers anglers prime conditions for a good catch!

In addition to the ponds and watercourses originally created for mining (UNESCO World Heritage Site "Oberharzer Wasserwirtschaft", a historical water supply system), you can also fish in the Oker reservoir

and the Innerste reservoir. The Harz waters are free of pollutants and therefore offer a large variety of species. In addition to brown trout and pike, zander, bass carp and eel can also be caught.

Fishing permits are available at the tourist information offices upon presentation of a fishing license.





Oberharz Historical Water Supply System & Mining

The highest located UNESCO World Heritage site consists of three parts: the old town of Goslar and the "Rammelsberg" ore mine, and the less well known "Oberharz Water Supply System".

This "masterpiece of human creativity" has been part of the World Heritage since 2010, joining the list alongside the Great Wall of China, the Statue of Liberty, and the Pyramids of Giza. From the 16th century onwards, Cistercian monks created ponds, trenches, and water channels with a total length of 341 km as a water supply system in order to use the energy for mining. Silver, lead, and copper were mined using hydropower alone until the 19th century. The "Oberharz water supply system" is thus one of the most important pre-industrial

energy supply systems in the world. Without the intensive use of water energy, the Harz would probably not have been able to develop into one of the most important

mining regions. **Today, the water supply system is a protected monument,** but still partly used for drinking water production. Find out more about this extraordinary mining region, which **you can explore**

in numerous mines, pits, and tunnels, underground and above, as well as on hikes through the landscape dotted with ponds.

Our tourist information offices will be happy to help with the selection and booking of tours and world heritage guides.





Recreation & health in a healing climate

The Oberharz is a natural spa region. Anyone who moves in it, allows nature to work its magic - whether on a walk or doing sports- and will feel how its peacefulness and strength take effect.

Experience this special feeling on a **guided spa hike** offered by the tourist information office, for example in Altenau

The impressions of the landscape of the Oberharz with its ponds, mountain meadows and the forest will invigorate your senses and gently soothe your soul.

Breathe in the clean air and bathe in the wonderful thermal water.

In the spa resort Altenau, you can do yourself and your health something good in the thermal bath "Kristalltherme".

In the herb park in Altenau - with well paved and easy to walk paths- you can learn about forgotten home remedies, natural medicinal herbs from "God's pharmacy".

Forest bathing

A certified forest educator will take you for a forest bath. Immerse yourself in the soothing atmosphere of nature, breathe the scent of the forest and enjoy the rustling of the leaves. Mindful walking and light breathing exercises will bring about inner peace and release new energy.

Forest bathing tours can be booked through the tourist information offices. The gentle breathing exercises help to become calm and let go of your thoughts.

Of course, **the magic of the forest** can also be experienced individually. In the brochure **"Hiking Experience Oberharz"** you will find **19 detailed tour suggestions** for hikes around the Oberharz towns and villages, with maps, route descriptions and reliable information on duration, length, and degree of difficulty.

Consistently used icons indicate for example family - and pram- accessible paths and senior-friendly trails.





Dog happiness in the Harz Mountains

The Oberharz lets dogs' hearts beat faster! Beautiful lakes and miles long hikes lead your four-legged companion through the Harz landscape and offer many an adventure.

Not only nature, but also the hosts welcome dogs, with pet-friendly accommodation that is designed for the needs of guests and dogs alike. The walks around the ponds of the Oberharz will be particularly en-

joyable: Here your companion can cool off in a variety of ways in the water. Dogs are **allowed to take a bath in almost all ponds in the Oberharz**, except in those providing drinking water (Fortuner Teich, Hirschler Teich and Kellerhalsteiche).

Please respect the general obligation for dogs **to be kept on a leash** in the National Park from April 1st to July 15th to protect wild animals.


Motorcycling

The Oberharz is a **popular region for motorcyclists** due to varied and sometimes even demanding route sections. On your tour you will experience winding mountain and country roads with fantastic views of the picturesque landscape.

Well-connected motorways make the journey to the Harz easy and straightforward.

Make a pit stop and enjoy refreshments with likeminded people, for example in the snack bars "Biker Treff Okertalsperre" and "Biker Treff Torfhaus".

You can obtain maps with tour suggestions and information on biker meet ups and accommodation from the tourist information offices.





Alpine skiing

In Altenau and Torfhaus you can find practice slopes and beautiful descents served by lifts, as well ski and snowboard schools and a ski rental.

The Ski-Alpinum in Schulenberg offers 4 downhill slopes, a practice slope- served by two double T-bar lifts- and a snowboard fun park. The neighboring towns of **Braunlage and Sankt Andreasberg** also offer large alpine ski and snowboard centres.

Cross-country skiing

The winter heart of the Oberharz locals beats above all for cross-country skiing. And that is no surprise! Most of the tracks are prepared for classic cross country, but skaterswill also get their money's worth. A highlight in Clausthal-Zellerfeld is the **illuminated skating track of the county's biathlon training centre**-internationally successful winter sport athletes from the Harz region come to train here! **Floodlit tracks** can also be found in Buntenbock.

Sledding, snow tubing and more

Every place in the Oberharz has its own sledding chute and winter hiking trails. Particularly popular with families with children is the sledding chute "Brockenblick", served by a lift, on Torfhaus and the chute beside the skiing slope "Rose" in Altenau.

Get a special sledding kick on the first **snow tubing facility** of the Harz in Sankt Andreasberg.

Guided hikes lit by torchlights are very romanticthey can be booked through the tourist information offices in the Oberharz.





Holidays- spicy and refreshing

The spa resort of Altenau- also a summer and winter sports resort- has much to offer: an extensive and signposted network of hiking and mountain bike trails, Europe's largest herb park, a DSV (German Sports Association) Nordic walking centre, a large saltwater spa and sauna area, wonderful spa hiking trails in the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage, the new "Goetheweg" path with connection to Torfhaus and a DiscGolf course.

We also recommend a visit to the **Altenau brewery**, the "**Heimatstube**" **Altenau/Schulenberg (museum)** and the **unique carving exhibition** "**Wunder in Holz**" (wooden wonders).

In winter you will find **prepared cross-country skiing tracks** with a connection to Torfhaus, a **ski slope served by a lift** and **wonderful winter hiking trails**.








The village of Schulenberg made way for the waters of the river "Oker" and was built anew on the "Wiesenberg" (meadowed mountain) with great views of the Okertalsperre. **The reservoir is a popular attraction** for walkers, skaters, and above all, water sports enthusiasts. The lake is **ideal for sailing, surfing, canoeing, and swimming**.

The Schulenberg Race Park, with downhill, freeride and slopestyle facilities, is a top address for extreme cyclists.

The "Skialpinum" offers slopes with various levels of difficulty appealing **to skiers and snow-boarders alike.**








Highest located holiday resort in Lower Saxony

Torfhaus is **located in the middle of the Harz National Park** and due to its convenient location, a direct view of the Brocken, and direct access to the hiking and cross-country skiing track network, it is a real magnet for visitors. From here you can follow the famous Goethe hiking trail with a connection to Altenau on foot or by mountain bike directly to the 1,141 m high Brocken and into the National Park.

The National Park visitor centre provides extensive information about the flora and fauna of the Harz.

In winter, up to 100 km of cross-country skiing tracks are prepared. A tow lift for skiers and snowboarders, and a sled lift, cater for all winter sports enthusiasts.




Oberharz holiday on the meadow

Buntenbock, the place where the river "Innerste" has its source, is located directly on the "Harzer Hexenstieg" (witch trail) and on the "Harzer Försterstieg" (ranger's trail), in the middle of the UNESCO World Heritage "Oberharz Water Supply System".

Explore Buntenbock and its idyllic surroundings, characterized by picturesque mountain meadows, idyllic forests, and numerous ponds.

Explore the "Buntenbocker Bergwiesenweg" (mountain meadow trail) and enjoy the colourful variety of plants, insects, and butterflies on the mountain meadows.







Oberharz holiday- rich in ideas

The mountain- and university town is located right in the middle of the UNESCO World Heritage Site "Oberharz Water Supply System". It is famous for its mining history, which can be experienced up close in the Oberharz Mining Museum- for example by visiting a mining tunnel- rebuilt true to the original. The Technical University attracts students from all over the world.

The Nobel prize winning physician and famous Clausthal native Robert Koch helped to shape the

city and even today you can walk in his footstep and visit numerous places that were of importance to his life.

From May to October **the farmer's market in Zel-lerfeld** offers typical regional products and craft every Thursday.

Events here range from **traditional folklore** to the **Indian SummerRace** and the **HarzClassix Festival**.






Tailor-made Oberharz holidays

The wild and romantic mountain town of Wildemann is nestled between the river "Innerste" and the "Spiegeltal" valley. Here you can relax in a charming natural landscape.

All around Wildemann you will find **beautiful hiking trails and quiet valleys** where clear streams flow and idyllic ponds invite you to linger. The place is one of the former seven Oberharz mountain towns that owe

their existence to mining. In the "19-Lachter-Stollen" visitor mine visitors get a fascinating insight into the working conditions underground.

Unique in the Harz Mountains and in Wildemann since 2015: "Glowgolf Harz"- an indoor minigolf played in black light.






Oberharz holiday- close to the stars

In the national park community of Sankt Andreasberg, you can count the stars. The **barrier-free observatory** Sankt Andreasberg promises **breathtaking views**. The symbol of the spa resort and one of the most beautiful sights is the **bell tower**.

The historical mine "Samson"- part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site "Oberharz Water Supply System"-offers impressive insights into mining history: do not miss its "Harzer Roller Museum" and learn about the role canary birds played!

A visit to the **high ropes course**, the **summer bobsleigh course** and the **mountain bike and downhill adventure park** is a must on any holiday in the Oberharz.






